

Signing your name to the class list means that you are absolutely committed to taking the class. Should you need to withdraw after the registration closes your kit will be given to you. There will no money refunded for ordering of kits. In rare cases exceptions to this may be made for compassionate reasons by application to the OVGS Treasurer. The Treasurer will submit the request to the OVGS Executive for review and approval.

It is recommended that you pay for the kit at the time of registration. Payment must be completed by the closure date for registration of your class. Any registrants that have not paid in full by the closure date will be required to provide their own kit supplies.

Delivery of kits will usually occur at the Guild meeting for your first class. You must make arrangements to pick up your kits at that meeting. If kits have not been claimed it is your responsibility to make arrangements with the Program chair to collect your kits at a mutually agreeable date and time. The Program chair is not responsible to chase after people in order to get their kits to them. Any kits that remain unclaimed by the end of the May Guild meeting will be handed over for the raffle at the June meeting.
